- a. Jesus gave us the authority and the power to pray for healing. The Holy Spirit provides us with gifts of healing and other spiritual gifts to edify the church.
- b. Jesus said we would do what He did!

2. People made whole and set free can live fully in the Spirit.

- a. Jesus came to heal the brokenhearted, provide freedom to what holds us captive, to make us whole emotionally, spiritually and physically.
- b. Churches are filled with people who hide their shame, pain and sin; therefore, those people are enslaved by fear, shame, pain and sin.

3. New ministries are formed in your church.

- a. Altar prayer, intercessory prayer teams, intensive personal prayer, home and hospital visitation teams, specialized prayer teams (like PTSD, deliverance, marriage restoration).

4. Passionate leaders who love Jesus are developed.
